**I. Call to Order / Roll Call:**

Chair Brad Ash called the meeting to order at 12:02 pm. Present were Board Members Brad Ash, Peggy Bergon, Chrissy Karas, Judy James and Planning Director James Dickhoff. Andre Redstone was absent.

**II. Decision Items:**

1) *Recommendation for TC to Provide Letter of Support for a New Scenic and Historic Vehicular Byway route in Archuleta County, the Tracks Across Borders Byway (TABB).*

The HPB discussed the proposed Scenic and Historic Byway project, and the fact the project is in the very initial stages of seeking Byway status. Once Byway status is achieved, there will be opportunities for private property owners to seek SHF grant funding for restoring historically significant structures and buildings as well as telling the history through interpretive signage and printed and electronic media.

Chrissy Karas motioned to approve a recommendation for Town Council to approve a letter of support for the proposed Vehicular Scenic Historic Byway, called the Tracks Across Borders Byway (TABB) project, that will extend between Antonito and Durango, noting the future opportunities for grant funding for restoring buildings along the route and interpretive information that will help share the history along the proposed byway. Judy James seconded the motion which was unanimously approved.

**III. Discussion:**

The HPB briefly discussed the next meeting and the consideration for revising the approved colors within the District. Board Chair Ash reminded board member to read through the materials provided by staff and conduct due diligence research, prior to the next meeting.

**IV. Adjournment:**

Chrissy Karas motioned to adjourn the meeting at 12:35pm. Judy James seconded the motion which unanimously passed.
