RESOLUTION NO. 2013-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PAGOSA SPRINGS, COLORADO SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TIGER V GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 5TH STREET VEHICULAR BRIDGE OVER THE SAN JUAN RIVER AND ROAD EXTENSION IN DOWNTOWN PAGOSA SPRINGS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pagosa Springs strongly supports the submittal of a 2013 USDOT Transportation Infrastructure Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER V) Grant Application for the PAGOSA SPRINGS 5th STRET VEHICULAR BRIDGE and ROAD EXTENSION project ; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pagosa Springs is requested grant funding up to \$6,169,410 from the TIGER V Grant Program to construct a Vehicular Bridge over the San Juan River and to construct the Road Extension to provide connectivity of traffic from Highway 160 crossing the San Juan River and connecting to Hot Springs Boulevard; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAGOSA SPRINGS,

Section 1: The Town Council of Pagosa Springs strongly supports the submittal of a 2013 TIGER V Grant application requesting up to \$6,169,410, and has approved the expenditure of \$325,000 for matching cash funds, to ensure the \$6,494,410 estimated vehicular bridge and road extension project is fully funded for completion.

Section 2: Town Council has included the 5th Street Vehicular Bride and road extension, into the Town's 5 year Capital Improvement Plan for year 2017, and has committed to budgeting funds to leverage grants for the completion of the project.

Section 3: If the TIGER V Grant is awarded, the Town Council of the Town of Pagosa Springs strongly supports and will prioritize the completion of the awarded grant project.

Section 4: The Town Council of the Town of Pagosa Springs authorizes staff to expend appropriated funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of an awarded grant.

Section 5: The properties associated with the developed components of this project are either owned by the Town of Pagosa Springs or will have a secured Easement dedicating land for the bridge and road extension that will remain under the Town's control for at least 25 years or the useful life of the project.

Section 6: The Town of Pagosa Springs will continue to maintain the developed infrastructure components in a high quality condition and will continue to appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budgets.

Section 7: The Town of Pagosa Springs has the ability to complete all proposed elements of this project by June 1, 2018 and has demonstrated the ability to complete grant funded projects in a timely fashion in a number of previous successful awarded projects.

Section 8: If the grant is awarded, The Town Council of The Town of Pagosa Springs authorizes either the Town Manager or Mayor, to sign the grant agreement with TIGER V.

Section 9: This resolution is to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
