Coronavirus (COVID-19) Protocol

In response to the threat posed by the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Pagosa Springs Municipal Court is immediately implementing the following policies:

- No cases shall be scheduled, and no summons shall be returnable, prior to May 11, 2020.
- The parties to cases previously scheduled before May 11, 2020, shall be permitted to appear by telephone without prior authorization of the Court.
- All jury trials, not in jeopardy of dismissal pursuant to C.M.C.R 248(b), shall be scheduled after May 11, 2020.
- All defendants shall be released from custody on their own recognizance, unless the Court specifically finds that the defendant poses a serious risk to the community.
- The Court shall implement additional cleaning and disinfecting procedures.
- Parties appearing in court shall be permitted 6 feet of personal space and space capacities shall be modified accordingly.
