RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAGOSA SPRINGS, COLORADO,  
ADOPTING THE ARCHULETA COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Town of Pagosa Springs recognizes the threat that natural and human-caused hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, Town of Pagosa Springs resides within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Archuleta County, the Pagosa Fire Protection District, and the Pagosa Area Water and Sanitation District also fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the public, and agency representatives that participate in the Archuleta County Multi-Agency Coordination Group and the Archuleta Joint Utilities Group, have had the opportunity to review the plan and provide feedback; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII officials have reviewed the Archuleta County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing bodies; and


