RESOLUTION NO. 2013-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PAGOSA SPRINGS, COLORADO SUPPORTING AND
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO GRANT
APPLICATION FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS 140 SOUTH 6TH
STREET IN DOWNTOWN PAGOSA SPRINGS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pagosa Springs strongly supports the submittal of a 2013 Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) Land Acquisition Grant Application for purchase of the property known as 140 South 6th Street, and if the grant is awarded, the Town of Pagosa Springs supports the completion of the project ; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pagosa Springs is requested grant funding up to \$140,000.00 from the GOCO Land Acquisition Grant Program to purchase the property known as 140 South 6th Street to provide the future connectivity and amenities of a river walk trail system along the San Juan River Corridor in downtown Pagosa Springs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAGOSA SPRINGS,

- Section 1: The Town Council of Pagosa Springs strongly supports the submittal of a 2013 GOCO Land Acquisition application requesting up to \$140,000, and has approved the expenditure of \$40,000 for matching cash funds, to ensure the \$180,000 estimated acquisition project is fully funded for completion.
- Section 2: Town Council has included the San Juan River walk trail and river Corridor recreational improvements, into the Town's Capital Improvement Plan, and has committed to annual budgeted funds to leverage additional grants for the continuation of the river walk along the San Juan River Corridor. This includes the development of the future McCabe Creek Park.
- Section 3: If the GOCO Land Acquisition Grant is awarded, the Town Council of the Town of Pagosa Springs strongly supports and will prioritize the completion of the awarded grant project.
- Section 4: The Town Council of the Town of Pagosa Springs authorizes staff to expend appropriated funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of an awarded grant.
- Section 5: The Town of Pagosa Springs has the ability to complete all proposed elements of this project by December 10, 2015 and has demonstrated the ability to complete grant funded projects in a timely fashion in a number of previous successful awarded projects.
- Section 6: If the grant is awarded, The Town Council of The Town of Pagosa Springs authorizes either the Town Manager or Mayor, to sign the grant agreement with Great Outdoors Colorado.
- Section 7: This resolution is to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
